

# Thriving in the Youth Scene



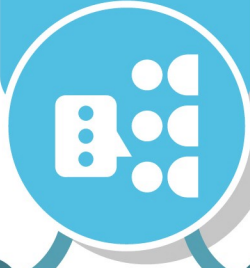
## Activate Youth Committee

Give them the seminar presentation and ask them to think about how to recruit. The committee should put a proposal together on resources the association/committee can provide.



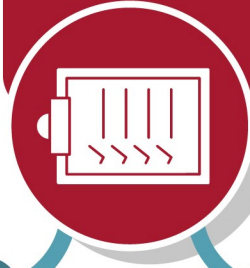
## Find volunteers

Use a variety of channels to communicate with your members. Focus on the benefits, be clear about the time commitment, and be direct in what you are asking for.



## Meet with centers

Determine which centers are interested in creating a new youth program and which would like to grow their existing youth program. How can you help the centers?



## Develop a plan

Work with the center to determine what fits their schedule and what may work for the youth in the community. Each center will be unique in what resources are available and what can be offered.



## Assign resources

Determine which volunteers will be assigned to each task. Determine if any monetary investment is available to aide the program.



## Deliver plan

Work with your partner center to ensure everyone is on the same page to promote and implement the new program. Have regular meetings to ensure everything stays on track.
