

QUICK FACTS - SCHOLARSHIP USAGE

Scholarship funds can be used at the following in-person or online educational institutions:

- a. Universities
- b. Colleges
- c. Business Schools
- d. Technical Schools
- e. Trade Schools
- f. Vocational Schools

Scholarship funds may be used for the following:

- a. Tuition/fees
- b. On-campus meal plans
- c. On- and off-campus housing
- d. Textbooks
- e. Required class supplies, including pens, paper and notebooks
- f. Equipment necessary for completion of a course or program, including a laptop or computer

Portal Requests

Scholarship fund disbursements made through the SMART Portal are paid directly to the secondary educational institution. You will need work with the school to utilize your SMART scholarship funds.

Transferring of Scholarships

Scholarship funds that have not yet expired are eligible to be transferred to a family member by a recipient who is 21 years of age or older. The family member must have at least four years of USBC membership history (does not have to be consecutive) and agree to the transfer. The family member must use the funds within eight years of their high school graduation.
